**Notification**

The 4th November, 2004

No. G.S.R. 31/Const./Art. 309/2004.—In Exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Haryana hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Haryana Ayurvedic, Homoeopathic and Unani Technical (Group C) Service Rules, 1997, namely:—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Haryana Ayurvedic, Homoeopathic and Unani Technical (Group C) Service (Amendment) Rules, 2004.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Haryana Ayurvedic, Homoeopathic and Unani Technical (Group C) Service Rules, 1997, in Appendix B, under Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4, for serial number 4 and entries there-against the following serial number and entries there-against shall be substituted, namely:—
