Notification

The 2nd June, 2004

No. G. S. R. 16/Const./Art. 309/2004.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Haryana hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Haryana Ayurvedic Education (Group A and B) Service Rules, 1999, namely :—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Haryana Ayurvedic Education (Group A and B) Service (Amendment) Rules, 2004.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Haryana Ayurvedic Education (Group A and B) Service Rules, 1999 (hereinafter called the said rules), in rule 9, sub-rule (1), under heading "Group-B" for clause (e) and entries thereunder, the following clause and entries thereunder shall be substituted, namely :—

"(e) in the case of Reader of Rachna Sharir,—

(i) by promotion from amongst the Lecturers of Rachna Sharir ;
or

(ii) by direct recruitment ; or

(iii) by transfer or deputation of an officer already in the service of any State Government or the Government of India ;".

3. In the said rules, in Appendix A, under columns 1 and 2, under heading "Group B", against serial number 5, for the words "Reader of Agad Tantra", the words "Reader of Rachna Sharir" shall be substituted.

4. In the said rules, in Appendix B, under columns 1, 2, 3 and 4, under heading "Group B", for serial number 5 and entries thereagainst, the following serial number and entries thereagainst shall be substituted, namely :—

5. In the said rules, in Appendices C and D, under columns 1 and 2, under heading "Group B", against serial number 5 for the words "Reader of Agad Tantra" the words "Reader of Rachna Sharir" shall be substituted.
